Organization-Chaos-Reorganization: REPEAT

The development of a child is like the growth of a new business. All businesses need certain basic systems. As your business grows, you will upgrade these systems until you must replace them. You may put up a sign: "Please bear with us as we upgrade our systems to better serve you."

During the transition period, disorganization will prevail as you learn the new systems. It may feel like chaos until the new systems are finally in place and running smoothly. Now, your business will operate more efficiently and serve your customers better. In time, the cycle, will need to be repeated if growth continues.

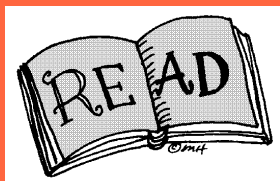
A similar process happens with children as they grow. Stages of chaos precede stages of organization. Your child may make strides (upgrades) in certain abilities and then need a "new system." During the transition, chaos may prevail and your child's behavior may fall apart. Skills that seemed to have been mastered may suddenly be off-line. You may think, "I know she knows better." Don't worry! Her disorganized state will be followed by a period of relatively calm, organized behavior and she will be able to demonstrate new or advanced skills.

Children's cycles of organization-chaos-reorganization happen about every six months starting around 15 months old. Reflect on your own life and you will see the same cycles. There are times we feel in charge of what we are doing and where we are going. Then we experience periods when we haven't a clue.

While we know these stages of disorganization must occur before the child can move onto stages of higher organization, no one can say just when these stages will occur or foresee the extent to which a child "breaks up" during the disorganized state or how smoothly times of reorganization will be. It is important to know this process is cyclical not linear. Generally, times of disorganization reveal that a great deal is happening internally. A child in the midst of a developmental shift may seem resistant, and even mean. The greater the struggle, the less the cooperation.
